Shot by the Sea is a film project which invites new and experienced film makers to make a 5 minute short film, 6 minutes including credits (Drama, documentary, music video or animation) as part of the Small Towns Big Ideas project. The project is supported by The Village Salthill. Teams and individuals are invited to come together from the local and regional community, share resources and make exciting short films and submit them before the 31st of October 2020.

What is The Challenge? To make a short film, shot by the sea. You can shoot your film on a mobile phone, film or your digital camera, we don't mind how you do it. We want



all sorts of shorts films, all genres – Comedy, Romance, Tragedy, History, Horror...whatever you like. We welcome all forms of film, narrative, experimental and animation, from right across the community. We know that there are some beautiful locations on our coastline and we challenge our filmmakers to use these in a new ways, new locations, new angles to tell exciting new stories.

Wild, fun and challenging, the Shot by the Sea film project is a community event supported by The Village Salthill. Teams and individuals are invited to come together from the local and regional community, share resources and make exciting short films. The event culminates in a gala public festival screening of the films in Salthill in November 2020. Filmmakers, community groups, schools and in fact **anybody who has a story to tell** and wants to take part in this exciting community project make a 5 minute short film is very welcome.

Ireland has a rich tradition in storytelling through film and what better location than along our stretch of the Wild



Atlantic Way. From Kinvara to Leenane, every town village and inch of coastline inspires new stories and throws up great natural locations.

Teams can now continue making their films. On 26th of November we will screen the best of the films in Salthill in an event open to the whole community.
